4-hour Charter

- **Egmont Key**
 - Snorkel the ruins of the Spanish American War era Fort DeSoto in the clear waters surrounding this historic Island. Tropical fish, stingrays, and other marine life are always in abundance.
 - Exploring the Island and a visit to its' historic lighthouse. First built in 1848, the Egmont Key lighthouse is one of the oldest operational lighthouses in Florida.
 - Dolphin sightings in the Gulf of Mexico are always a highlight of any day on the water. If they are in the mood, they may even show off their surfing skills.
- **Shell Key Preserve**
 - Shell collecting on the Shell Key Preserve. This small island is known for its' abundance of exotic shells.
 - Beach excursions on Shell Key Preserve. Spend some time just relaxing on the pristine sand beaches of the island.
 - As one of many bird sanctuaries found in Florida, bird watching is also popular on the Island.
- **Cruising the intracoastal waterway**
 - Take a leisurely cruise along the ICW and its many drawbridges, past the Sunshine Skyway bridge, John's Pass, St. Pete Beach, Treasure Island, and Downtown Gulfport.
- **Sand bar trips**
 - Anchor off one of many popular sand bars for lunch and a swim.

Full-Day Charter

- **Historic Fort DeSoto Tours**
 - Guided historic tours of the Spanish American War era Fort DeSoto by published historian Capt. Scott. Tour includes the 1898 remains of fortifications including barracks, original cannon, magazines, and Civil War cemetery. This fort was later used during WW II and renamed

Fort Dade. Visit the Fort DeSoto lighthouse, one of the oldest operating lighthouses in Florida.

- **Intracoastal Waterway Tour**
 - Cruise the waters of the ICW past the communities of historic Gulfport, St. Pete Beach, John's Pass, Treasure Island, and Clearwater, with stopovers at pristine island beaches, shopping, and countless tiki bars.
- **Clearwater Excursion**
 - Visit the popular tourist destination of Clearwater beach with its hundreds of restaurants, bars, and sugar-sand beaches.
- **Beach Excursion**
 - Drop anchor for an afternoon at one of the countless beaches and sandbars to be found in this area.
- **Fort DeSoto Snorkeling**
 - Spend a day anchored off the historic ruins of Fort DeSoto for a snorkeling adventure in the clear waters surrounding the Spanish American War era fort. This snorkeling site is known for its clear water and the abundance of tropical fish.
- **John's Pass Shopping**
 - Spend an afternoon exploring the numerous shops, restaurants, taverns and attractions of the quaint village of John's Pass, on Madeira Beach.
- **St. Petersburg Excursion**
 - Visit beautiful downtown St. Petersburg. Attractions include the recently completed "Pier", the Dali Museum, featuring the works of Surrealist artist Salvador Dali, the Vinoy Park, and numerous shops, restaurants and bars.
- **Anna Maria Island**
 - Spend the day at the beautiful artist's community of Anna Maria Island. Browse the numerous galleries, boutiques, and shops, then enjoy a meal at one of many restaurants to be found there.

Overnight

- **Egmont Key**
 - Spend a couple days enjoying the waters surrounding the Island, then spend a night at anchor at historic Fort DeSoto.
- **Vinoy Park**
 - Spend an evening at the dock of the Vinoy resort, exploring the restaurants, bars, galleries, and sport's venues of downtown St. Petersburg.
